Any Activity organized by a registered u3a and undertaken in accordance with Branch Guidelines automatically comes under the Public Liability Insurance cover taken out by the u3a National body, the Third Age Trust. This Insurance protects the leaders and group members against any claims for damage to property and for injury or death that might occur during a meeting. This is **NOT** a personal accident insurance and no financial compensation or assistance will be paid to members for any loss or injury. Members are therefore responsible for their own Health and Safety and the safeguarding of their own equipment, clothing and belongings during a meeting.

Apart from when taking part in the Walking or other Group undertaking an outdoor activity or when on a Trip or Outing, most meetings will take place indoors at a venue such as a meeting room or in a private home.

If the meeting is held in a hired room, the venue may have its own arrangements for what to do in the case of an Emergency, illness or accident, but as a general rule, and according to the circumstances, the group convenor, contact or leader's responsibility will not extend beyond arranging for the appropriate professionals to attend in the case of any minor illness or accident.

Participants in group (and Branch meetings) should follow the guidelines of the group and behave in a reasonable manner at all times, and ensure that they do not endanger their own lives or that of others in the group.

It is suggested that you may wish to keep the following information on you when you attend meetings and events and you may also choose to complete the details on this form if you feel that it would be relevant to any treatment by health professionals in the event of a serious accident or illness. Any details thus given will be treated as confidential and passed onto the medical professionals should a situation arise.
